**Hillsdale County Community Foundation YOUTH  
Announce Summer Grant Awards**

Hillsdale, MI, July 8, 2011 –

The Hillsdale County Community Foundation is pleased to announce the recipients of the most recent YOUTH grant cycle. A total of **\$37,486.79** has been awarded to area non-profit organizations for projects or programs to benefit young people in Hillsdale County.

The following organizations were awarded funding through the Kellogg Youth Advisory Fund:

- Camden-Frontier Schools, \$1,600 for an elementary summer literacy book club and exchange program;
- Hillsdale County Intermediate School District, \$1,850 for the 2011 Arts Day Camp;
- Hillsdale County Senior Services Center, \$1,196 for camperships for youth in the Kinship Care program;
- Community Action Agency, \$12,840.79 for the ABC Music & Me Laugh and Learn Music Program for Head Start classrooms; and
- Kimball Camp YMCA, \$20,000 for a 15-passenger van.
